

Project name: Inspectors Training for Compliance Monitoring in the Sudanese Petroleum Industry

Summary: The program was targeted at personnel working for official authorities related to regulating the oil and gas industry; within the areas of safety and environment.

The main objectives of the program were for participants to obtain:

- An overall understanding of the oil and gas industry,
- A general understanding of how the oil industry is regulated,
- A general understanding of the role of safety and environmental authorities,
- An overview of technical aspects and procedures of process and drilling area,
- An overview of environmental aspects of the oil and gas industry,
- Theoretical and practical understanding of safety and crisis management.
